SOLOMON ISLANDS

This is an island country in the South Pacific Ocean. Its largest islands are Choiseul, Guadalcanal, Malaita, New Georgia, San Cristobal, and Santa Isabel. Its many other islands include Bellona, Rennell, and the Santa Cruz Islands.

The country's largest islands are also called the Solomon Islands. But not all the islands in the chain belong to the country. Bougainville, Buka, and a few smaller islands in the northern part of the chain are part of Papua New Guinea.

The United Kingdom (UK) ruled the Solomons from 1893 to 1978, when the islands became independent. Honiara, on Guadalcanal, is the capital and largest community that has a population of about 60,000 today.

The Catholic Church in the Solomon Islands is just a little about a hundred years old. It was established by the Marist Missionaries who are strong in the Pacific. They have done a great job in establishing the Church - some even dying for the faith. They share the mission with other congregations among which are the Dominicans, Vincentians, Salesians and MSP. The Salesians are happy to be part of the growth of youth in Solomon Islands.

GIVING QUALITY TO MISSIONARY ANIMATION


